DESCRIPTION

Spikes of rich violet-blue flowers cover lacy, fragrant foliage.

Bloom begins in July and continues right through September, which makes Russian Sage an exceptionally long-blooming perennial.

Plants are vigorous and very hardy, ignoring heat, drought, and pests, while always looking fresh.

Deer and rabbit resistant.
